PROPOSITIONS

1. Surface fishing shall be allowed at Shipton Lake, but the baits are not to be closer than 20ft from the lilies. Zig rig fishing continues to be banned.

2. All anglers under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult who shall be responsible for their actions.

3. With effect from 1 January 2018, all Bradford City AA Fisheries shall be catch & release, **including** pike under 5lb.

4. Unhooking mats are required by all coarse anglers when fishing all Bradford City AA waters.

5. That keep nets be banned on all Bradford City AA waters unless being used in a “bona fide” fishing match.

6. Carp of any size must not to be kept in keep nets unless caught in a “bona fide” fishing match when they may be retained in a **carp friendly** keep net, but must be returned to the water immediately after weighing.

7. All fish over 6” must be landed with the aid of a landing net.

8. With effect from 1 January 2019 the Junior membership rate shall apply to anglers aged 16 and under and they shall be entitled to receive free membership of the Association upon application to either the General Secretary or by purchasing membership through the online shop. The membership will entitle them to fish with 1 rod & line only. Should they wish to fish with a second rod, a permit may be purchased by writing direct to the General Secretary enclosing name, address, membership number and payment of £10 plus postage. In addition, the Adult membership rate shall be amended to anglers aged 17 to 64 inc.

9. From 1 January 2019 the Adult rate shall increase to £42 and the Concessionary rate to £27. In addition, Adult, Concessionary, Complimentary and Part Year members will be allowed to fish with a second rod at no extra cost. Consequently the 2nd rod membership is cancelled for these classifications of membership.
