- Dry fly fishing leaders, fly selection, reading the water.
- Wet fly fishing getting set up, fishing a team of flies, techniques.
- Nymph fishing types of techniques, 9 essential skills.
- Dry/dropper fishing set up, dealing with currents.
- Streamer fishing set up, fly selection, tactics.
